

ATTENTION: PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY

Certain testing ordered by our office are not performed in our office and are sent to another party. These range from blood work we draw and send out for testing to diagnostic radiology test we send you to have. It is your responsibility to check with your insurance prior to this testing to see if pre-certification is required or if the facility is in network. Our verification of insurance for in-network is made for our physician, procedures or testing performed in our office **only** not on testing sent out. We will be happy to assist you but again this is required by your insurance carrier and ultimately is your responsibility. If you are having blood work or being sent for testing you may first want to verify coverage with your insurance company directly and to ask your insurance if they are in-network. Failure to do so could result in a bill to you. It is the patient responsibility to notify us if your insurance requires you to use a certain lab or facility prior to the blood work being sent or testing being ordered. We use several labs and Diagnostic Testing Centers. To find out what you need to verify with your insurance please ask your nurse or receptionist at the time of test or scheduling. Note: As told by the insurance company at the time of discussion pre-certifications and authorizations given by insurance carriers are not a guarantee of payment.
